As we recap our fiscal year that ended on June 30, some accomplishments we are most proud about are:

- Two housing projects are now underway. One home is near completion in Spring Lake and the other is in Erwin. Habitat anticipates beginning a third house in the near future. The selection process for homeownership is well under way.
- Three critical repair projects were completed. Two in the Dunn area and the other in the western part of the county. These projects were rebuilding a deck and two ramps for seniors and a disabled individual. Habitat would like to thank these volunteers for their help---Matt Willis, Steve Pierce, Kenneth Snipes and Ethan Hayes.
- Charitable giving supporting the mission increased 100%+, raising nearly \$230,000. We thank the community for their investment in Habitat and in affordable housing.
- Our ReStore welcomed volunteer groups from Triton High School, JCI and First Bank.
- Habitat welcomed some new board members this year. These individuals will help our organization expand our capacity to help us make a greater impact.
